

AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION



This Constitution Amendment is adopted by the General Assembly on 7th April 2026, in accordance with Article 3 of Chapter 1 of the *Student Club Handbook (12th Edition)* (also known as "Club Handbook (12th Edition)"), issued by the Student Club Support Centre Division of the Student Affairs Office.

Article I. Organisation

- Section 1.** The official full name of this organisation shall be "Psychology Association of XJTLU," the standard short name shall be "Psychology Association," and the acronym shall be "PSYA."
- Section 2.** The purpose of the organisation is to foster a positive campus atmosphere, enhance the psychological well-being of its members, and disseminate psychological knowledge among the XJTLU community.
- Section 3.** The organisation shall operate under the leadership of the Student Counselling Centre of XJTLU; the Academic Advisor shall be appointed by it and shall have the authority to veto any decision of the Association concerning its affairs.

Article II. Membership

- Section 1.** The organisation is free to accept new Members without regard to race, religion, national origin, ethnicity, colour, age, gender, marital status, citizenship, or disability.
- Section 2.** Membership is limited to students currently enrolled at XJTLU. Each Member has equal rights and privileges. No membership fee shall be charged.
- Section 3.** For the organisation to be recognized by XJTLU, a minimum of twenty (20) XJTLU students need to be Members.
- Section 4.** The General Assembly, composed of all Members, shall be the supreme authority of the organisation.
- Section 5.** The General Assembly may decide on any matter concerning the organisation and shall exercise its power by convening at least once per semester.

Article III. Management

- Section 1.** The Management Team of the organisation shall consist of the

Officers and the Department Staff of each Department.
Departments shall be the standing executive bodies of the organisation.

Section 2. All members of the Management Team shall be elected from among the Members of the organisation. The President and Vice President shall be directly elected by the General Assembly in a contested election.

Section 3. An Officer means a Student Leader of the organisation, as defined in Section 1 of Article 6 of Chapter 1 of the *Student Club Handbook (12th Edition)*, issued by the Student Club Support Centre Division of the Student Affairs Office, or any subsequent version thereof, i.e.:

(a) the President, who shall be the head of the organisation and the leader of the management team;

(b) the Vice President, who shall be the deputy leader of the Management Team and co-lead the team with the President;

(c) the Director of a Department, who shall be the head and the chief of the Department; or

(d) the Co-Director of a Department, who shall be the deputy to the Director of the Department, and the deputy head and the “minister” of the Department, whose term “minister” is defined in Section 1 of Article 6 of Chapter 1 of the *Student Club Handbook (12th Edition)*, issued by the Student Club Support Centre Division of the Student Affairs Office.

Section 4. The Officer Meeting shall be composed of all Officers. The Officer Meeting may act on behalf of the General Assembly in handling routine affairs of the organisation, subject to the Bylaws, provided that any decision made by the Officer Meeting shall be subordinate to a resolution of the General Assembly, except that the Officer Meeting shall not have the power to:



- (a) amend the Constitution;
- (b) interpret the Constitution; or
- (c) elect or remove the President or Vice President.

Section 5. When the Officer Meeting adopts or amends the Bylaws, the following quorum and voting requirements must be met:

- (a) at least two-thirds of all Officers be present, and
- (b) at least two-thirds of those present vote in the affirmative.

Section 6. The impeachment of any member of the Management Team shall be governed by Article 6 of Chapter 6 of the *Student Club Handbook (12th Edition)*, issued by the Student Club Support Centre Division of the Student Affairs Office, or any subsequent version thereof.

Article IV. Miscellaneous Provisions

Section 1. The regular withdrawal procedure shall be governed by Article 2 of Chapter 11 of the *Student Club Handbook (12th Edition)*, issued by the Student Club Support Centre Division of the Student Affairs Office, or any subsequent version thereof.

Section 2. The *Interim Measures for the Internal Elections of the 2026-2027 Management Team of Psychology Association of XJTLU* shall remain valid and shall apply exclusively to the formation of the management team for the 2026-2027 term.

Section 3. The previous Constitution shall be null and void in its entirety.

Section 4. This Constitution Amendment shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the General Assembly.
